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Advertising Trades

There are as many ways to advertise as there are people, and what appeals to one may not appeal to another. Advertisers are people also. They have carpet, upholstery, wood flooring, tile and grout, or VCT that needs to be cleaned. Making a trade of cleaning services for advertising can be very little out of pocket money for you. You may want to consider trading with every radio and TV station in your area. You clean their stuff first, and then you get advertising instead of getting paid money. This works out well for both of you because you both have next to nothing in out-of-pocket expense.

It is easy to set things up on a maintenance basis so you are in there cleaning every three to four months. Each time you clean, it is easier and takes you less time than if they were only cleaning once a year.

We have set up a program like this with our local newspaper. The first time we cleaned it we did 70 chairs and all of their carpet. The bill to them was \$1,050.00. We are cleaning two office locations every 3 months. We are trading them for flier inserts in the newspaper. They will even print the insert. We can trade for a little sticky note that we be stuck on the front page of the paper. I am not sold on a normal advertisement in the paper, but they have a lot of options for our ads which even include online advertising. We have suggested to them that they give each of their full time employees a three room carpet cleaning special (\$99.00 Value) as a thank you to the employee. When the certificate is turned in to us we charge the newspaper \$99.00 but we trade that for more advertising. No out of pocket money for either of us, but we both get benefit from it. It turns into a real win-win situation for us both.

Employers look for ways to keep their employees loyal and happy. Little incentives like this work out well. Yes it takes some time and a little product, but it can return great dividends.
